JUTA continues protest ignoring HC order

STALEMATE in administrative activities continued for the 35th consecutive day as Jahangirnagar University Teachers' Association ignored High Court order issued on Wednesday.

The High Court on Wednesday directed the Jahangirnagar University authorities to take immediate

necessary steps in resuming all the administrative works.

The HC also asked the government, University Grants Commission, the JU administration, the inspector general of police and JU Teachers' Association to take action in this regard.

However, the JUTA members regarded the High Court order as 'shameful'.

The High Court notice

has not yet been received. We will declare new programme after we get it,' said president of JUTA Professor Ajit Kumar Majumder.

VC Professor Anwar Hossain told New Age that the High Court order could not be violated and initiatives would be taken after receiving the order.

The HC came up with the order and rule after

hearing a petition jointly filed by four teachers and a student on July 7 seeking necessary HC directives in this regard.

JUTA has been demanding resignation of VC Prof Anwar Hossain since April 7 for not expelling JU unit Bangladesh Chhatra League General Secretary Rajib Ahmed Rasel for physically assaulting a teacher.
