

Proctor among 8 injured in clash between BCL men of 2 JU halls

EIGHT people including the Jahangirnagar University proctor were injured in a clash between two hall units of Bangladesh Chhatra League at the university on Wednesday.

The injured seven activists of the ruling Awami League-backed student organisation were admitted to the university medical centre.

Eight restaurants at Botola were also vandalised during the clash.

Sources said that some junior activists of AFM Kamal Uddin Hall unit including Masud Parves (38th batch student of government and politics department) beat up senior activist of Banghabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Hall unit Riyad (36th batch student of pharmacy) following

an altercation over catching fish in the swimming pool.

Following the incident the activists of the two halls locked into a clash with lethal weapons injuring seven of them — Asif Ahmed (39th batch student of chemistry), Rasel Ahmed (41st batch student of physics, Roni (41st batch student of anthropology, Badhon (41st batch student), Masuk (41st batch student of govern-

ment and politics), Rana (39th batch student of economics) and Monowar Hossen Setu (39th batch student of botany).

The proctor, Shohel Ahmed, was also hurt as he rushed the spot and tried to control the situation.

The proctor said that the situation was now under control and stern action would be taken against the perpetrators after investigation.
