

## JU expels 4 BCL men for attacking students

THE Jahangirnagar University administration on Thursday expelled four activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League, student organisation, backed by ruling Awami League, on charge of beating three students of the university on Wednesday.

Of the four Asfiqur Sagor and Mohitos Ray Titu have been expelled for one year while Taimur Rasel and Salauddin Parvez for six months.

JU vice-chancellor Professor Anwar Hossain told New Age that until further official notice the expelled students would not be allowed on the campus.

All of the expelled are JU history department students and also resident of Mir Mosharraf Hossain Hall of the university.

On Wednesday, three on-duty Bangladesh National Cadet Corps and Rover Scout members came under BCL attack when the election result of History Sangsad was declared at around 5:30pm in front of the New Arts Faculty building.

The attackers were the losers in the polls and so they launched the attack, campus sources said.

The injured history department students are Mejbaur Rahman Mahin CEO of BNCC of JU, cadet-corporal Nahidur Rahman Himel and Afjal Jahan Imran, JU unit chief Rover-mate.
