

**Jucusu polls suspended**  
*Confinement of pro-VCs goes on*

In the face of students' protest, the election to Jahangirnagar University Central Students Union (Jucusu) was suspended for an indefinite period yesterday.

IU students have been demonstrating for the last couple of days against allowing MPhil and PhD researchers to contest and vote in the poll slated for January 2.

In a press note, Chief Election Commissioner of the Jucusu poll Prof AKM, Shahnewaz said that considering the parliamentary election scheduled for January 5, they decided to suspend all activities involving the Jucusu poll from December 1.

Meanwhile, the confinement of Pro-Vice Chancellor (education) Prof MA Matin and Pro-VC (admin)
