

NU students, police clash in Gazipur

AT LEAST five students were injured in a clash between National University students and law enforcers in Gazipur on Sunday.

As part of the protest against grading system, the students blocked Dhaka-Mymensingh highway.

A dozen of vehicles were also vandalised during the demonstration.

Meanwhile, NU students of Bogra Government Azizul Haque College demanded cancellation of the new

grading system under which only 54 per cent of students passed the examination.

The NU authorities announced the result on July 16.

The blockade programme by the NU students in Gazipur and Bogra instigated the protests in different parts of the country including the capital city.

However, pro-vice-chancellor of the NU Professor Mlnaz Ahmed Noor ruled out any chance of changing the new grading system.
