## Provost, 4 house tutors of a BAU hall resign

The provost and four house tutors of Fazilatunnesa Mujib Hall at Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) have resigned alleging that the Chhatra League activists of the university unit misbehaved with them.

They are provost AKM Shamsuddin, house tutors Md Azharul Islam, Poly Karmaker, Zobedatun Nahar and Md Zaman Hossain.

Sources said, the activists of the student wing of ruling Awami League had been setting banners highlighting the government's success in different points on the campus for the last few days.

As part of it, they hung two banners in front of the hall gate on November 24. But the authorities removed them as they put them without due permission.

Enraged by the incident, a group of agitated activists led by BCL president Md

Mursheduzzaman Khan Babu brought out a procession, demanding resignation of the hall provost.

Later, they gathered in front of the hall gate and hurled abuse at provost AKM Shamsuddin.

On information, Prof Md Sulatn Uddin Bhuiya along with proctor Shahidur Rahman Khan rushed in and expressed sorrow on behalf of the hall provost. They also ensured the BCL men of bearing of 20 more banners.

Protesting the incident, the four later submitted their resignation letters to registrar Md Abdul Khaleque on November 28.

"The vice chancellor is yet to accept the resignation letters. We are looking into the matter", said the registrar.

BAU unit BCL president Babu, however, said that there was no link between the resignations and the incident as both sides had reached an accord over the issue on the day.
