

Strike enforced at SUST

GENERAL students enforced a strike at Shahjalal University of Science and Technology in Sylhet on Monday protesting against attack on two of their fellows.

Miscreants attacked Physics department Masters student Imran Hossain Nayan and statistics department final year student Khalilur Rahman Nahid while they were returning to hall from university's main gate.

Although the students had gone on strike for an indefinite period, they postponed the programme till July 14. The acting vice-chancellor assured them of taking immediate steps against the attackers.

No classes and scheduled examinations were held on

Monday due to the strike.

Students gathered in front of university main gate on Monday morning and locked the main gate as part of their protests, witnesses said.

The protestors demanded immediate arrest of the miscreants and proper security on the campus.

Proctor Himadri Shekhor Roy and student affairs adviser Anowarul Islam rushed the spot and tried to soothe the protesters.

The protestors said that they would go for tougher programmes if their demands were not met.

Proctor Himadri Shekhor Roy said that a three-member probe committee was formed and extra police were been deployed at the campus.
