PRIVATE COACHING 811 teachers blacklisted

THE government has blacklisted 811 teachers of 266 secondary schools and madrasahs for continuing with coaching business flouting officials said.

An education ministry official told New Age on Tuesday that notices had been issued to all these teachers to explain their position and anyone giving unsatisfactory reply to the notices might not receive their salaries or even lose jobs.

Of the total such teachers, 285 are from 272 secondary schools and 26 from 14 madrasahs, according to a list an intelligence agency prepared. New Age has obtained a copy of the list.

The list includes 13 teachers from two government secondary schools of Dhaka and Rajshahi and four more teachers of the Rajshahi government madrasah.

Giving his opinion on the enlistment that has ignored education ministry officials on Wednesday said that he

know that some teachers of the Government Laboratory High School, Dharmoady Government Boys' School and Moujheel Government Boys' School in the capital Dhaka were engaged in coaching business but they had not been enlisted.

The government on June 20, 2012 announced a policy to stop coaching business, directing teachers to stop providing private tuition for students of their own institutions.

Branding coaching a punishable offence, the policy also prohibited becoming owners or being attached directly or indirectly with any coaching centres.

The policy, however, allowed teachers to give private tuition to a maximum of 10 students of other schools with permission of the head of the teachers own institution.

But the agency people found that all the blacklisted teachers had been giving coaching to 30 to 500 students of their own institutions and even some of them were engaged in commercial coaching centres. Some of the teachers have rented flats or rooms to carry out their coaching business.

The institutions having teachers blacklisted in the capital include Vigarumisa Sanwar Hossain, a mathematics teacher of Rajshahi Government Madrasah, Hossain of Mandara Para Senior Madrasah at Dhuna in Bogra is involved in Bright Coaching Centre.
