



Convocation of AUST April 22

The Ahsanullah University of Science and Technology (AUST) will hold its first convocation on April 22 at Osmani Memorial Auditorium, Dhaka. President Professor A.Q.M. Badruddoza Chowdhury and Chancellor of the University will preside over the convocation ceremony and confer degrees.

Dr M. Osman Faruk, Minister for Education will be present as the guest of honour while Prof. Wahiduddin Ahmad, President, Diabetic Association of Bangladesh will be the convocation speaker. Kazi Rafiqul Alam, Executive Director, Dhaka Ahsania Mission and Kazi Fazlur Rahman, Chairman of the Syndicate, Professor M. H. Khan, Vice-Chancellor of AUST will address the audience.

Graduates of sessions from 1997-98 to 2000-2001 under different faculties of the university have been requested to register their names by 11 April at the latest in the office of the Registrar of the university by applying in the prescribed form and on payment of a fee of Taka 1,000/-. Necessary briefing will be provided to the registered graduates from the office of the Registrar at the time of registration.

It may be mentioned that AUST is the first private sector science and technological university in Bangladesh established in 1995. The university is sponsored by Dhaka Ahsania Mission, the recipient of Independence Award-2002 for social/public service.
