



IS told Students of Haji Danesh College won't be affected

DHAKA, Mar 18:— Education Minister Dr Osman Faruq on Sunday told the jatiya Sangsad that the education ministry would take measures so that the students now studying in Haji Danesh Agriculture college could continue their curriculum unaffected when the college would be turned into a Science and Technology University, reports BSS.

Making statement on a call attention notice by JP (Ershad) member from Thakurgaon Hafiz Uddin Ahmed, the minister said that the present Haji Danesh Agriculture College would be turned into Haji Danesh Science and Technology University. But the university would give more stress on agriculture education in its curriculum.

The education Minister said that an agriculturalist would be appointed as Vice Chancellor of the University.

He said, as the process for setting up of the Haji Danesh Science and Technology College has already been taken up, it is not possible to set up another university in Dinajpur.

In his call attention notice Jatiya Party member Hafiz Uddin Ahmed proposed for setting up an agriculture university centering the Haji Danesh Agriculture College in Dinajpur.
