

Narail Govt Girls High School facing shortage of English teachers

NARAIL, Mar. 19 — The classes of Bengali, English, Social Science, Mathematics and Physical Training are being seriously hampered due to acute shortage of teachers in Narail Government Girls High School for years hence.

It is learnt reliably that the total number of sanctioned posts of teachers in Narail Government Girls High School is 27 but of them, 9 posts including that of headmaster, assistant headmaster have been lying vacant for long thus obstructing the school administration.

At present there are only 18 teachers to teach about 700 students in the school. A total of 26 sections are there in the school.

Besides the headmaster and assistant headmaster the school does not have teachers for the

main subjects such as two teachers in Bengali, two in English, one in social science, one in mathematics and one teacher for physical training. Despite the functioning staff these are 3 teachers who are now on leaves, one on maternity and one on computer training.

As a result the total 26 sections of the classes are being hampered due to shortage of teachers.

The posts of headmaster and assistant headmaster have been lying vacant since March 18, 1999 and January 5, 2002 respectively.

The school authority has repeatedly apprised the higher authority of the vacancy situation but no positive response has yet been made.

The guardians of the students of the school are seriously concerned over the situation.
