

BCL vows to make DU campus free of Shibir activities

Dhaka University unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) on Tuesday vowed to make student dormitories and cultural organizations free of Islamic Chhatra Shibir, reports UNB.

BCL's DU unit leaders urged the general students and other progressive student organizations to work 'hand in hand' to ensure a Shibir-free campus.

The call was made from a meeting of the DU Chhatra League unit held at the DUCSU building in the afternoon.

Sources in the meeting said BCL leaders would meet the university authorities soon to know about what the administration so far has done to protect the campus from Shibir activities.

Shibir's activities are banned on the Dhaka University campus by the Paribesh Parishad committee comprising representatives of student organizations in Dhaka University.

DU BCL general secretary Sazzad Sakib Badsha said general and progressive students are concerned about the secret activities of the Shibir. "Now it is our sacred duty to ensure that our university will not be polluted by a fanatic force."
