Teachers training on New SSC exam system for 2010 continuing in Barisal

* BARISAL, Jan 28:—Training of the secondary school teachers has been started in Barisal recently for giving lessons to prepare examinees of secondary school certificate examination of 2010 under a new system of examination.

Abul Kalam Azad, working as an examination and evaluation expert in examination development unit of Dhaka Education Board and supervising the training program in Barisal said that in this new curriculum of SSC level examination stress has been given on achieving clear conception, acquiring proper knowledge and developing imagination rather than memorization of the limited course papers and notes.

In the new system each question paper would be divided into four parts as chapters of acquiring knowledge, clarifying conception, implementation procedure of study and developing procedure of higher imagination.

Examinees have to touch and answer all parts of the question paper and would not be able to pass the examination depending only on memorization of certain parts or note papers, he added.

Barisal Education Board authority sources said already training of about 80 thousand secondary school teachers in the country have been completed and training had been disrupted for the time being in southern region due to Sidr.

In Barisal district 2664 teachers of secondary schools would be trained and as a part of this program training of 216 teachers has been started at Barisal Halima Khatun girl's school on Saturday last.

Every day each batch consists

with teachers of Bangla 1st paper, mathematics, Islamic religion, general science, social science and agriculture from 36 schools participating in this training program, said Shah Alamgir, Controller of Examination of Barisal Education Board.

Success in examination under the new system would depend on the giving proper lesson by the teachers and creativeness of the students and it also improve fair and copy-free environment of examination, he added.

Mokammel Huq, District Education Officer, M M Amzad Hussein and Ebadul Islam, headmasters of Halima Khatun Girls and Govt. Zilla School of Barisal, hailing the newly introducing system said students under this system would learn their lesson properly and deeply and could develop their power of knowledge, conception, imagination and creativeness for adjusting with every day changing world.

Tasnia Binte Sarwar, a student of class nine of government sadar girls school and Kamrul Hasan Asif, student of class nine of Govt. Zilla school of Barisal said new system would be very hard for them as it was not introduced from primary level of education and its success depends on the ability and quality of teacher in giving lessons to the students properly as well as standard and environment of the educational institution.
