

BCL men arrested for damaging idols

SEVEN activists of the ruling Awami League-backed student organisation Bangladesh Chhatra League were detained and handed over to police by local people on allegation of damaging idols at a Hindu temple at Chairman Bari of Wazirpur upazila in Barisal on Monday night.

Four people were injured while they tried to resist attackers and to protect idols, materials of worships, also damaged by the Chhatra League men.

The arrested seven was identified as Chhatra League ward unit president Mehedi Hasan and activists Shamim Mridha, Badiul Islam, Masud Sheikh, Miraj Hoaladar, Miraj Fakir, Sukdev Sarkar of Syedkathi union of Banaripara upazila.

Wazirpur police station officer-in-charge Nurul Islam said that temple committee president Uttam Biswas filed a case in this connection on Tuesday.
