

Medical college aspirants break hunger strike

MEDICAL admission seekers, who went on a hunger strike unto death at the central Shaheed Minar on Wednesday morning, broke their strike on Thursday evening.

The called off the strike following assurance from some eminent personalities of establishing a 'mass court' at the central Shaheed Minar from October 19 to press home their demand.

Jahangirnagar University teacher Prof Anu Mohammad, columnist Syed Abul Maksud

and journalist Abu Sayeed Khan assured the striking students of forming the mass court and urged them to break the hunger strike.

Earlier on Wednesday, the medical aspirants went on the hunger strike as a part of their movement demanding cancellation of the results of the admission tests of MBBS and Bachelor of Dental Surgery as they claimed that question papers of the tests were leaked.

Seven students were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital as they fell sick during the hunger strike on Wednesday.
