

DU puts ban on entrance of outsiders, vehicles after 6:00pm on 31st night

THE Dhaka University authorities have put a moratorium on entrance of outsider and traffic after 6:00pm on December 31, for the sake of security and maintaining law and order situation during New Year celebration.

The notice came in a DU statement, signed by acting director of public relations department Noor-E-Islam.

The statement also requested the residents of the campus to reach their house by 8:00pm.

A new Gregorian calendar year is celebrated universally every year on January 1 that begins at zero hour.
