

IBA admission seekers want previous rule reinstated

STUDENTS seeking admission in the Institute of Business Administration of Dhaka University on Saturday demanded reinstating its previous rules that allowed aspiring candidates to take examinations for the second time.

The newly initiated move of the students came up weeks after the IBA authorities on September 16 issued a circular saying only the students who passed Higher Secondary Certificate in 2015 can take part in the IBA entry tests under 2015-16 academic sessions.

The students made the demand at a press conference held at Madhur Canteen.

On behalf of the admission seekers, Eftekhar Ebneey Alam read out the written statement.

The aspirants will hold demonstration today at the base of Raju Memorial Sculpture on the campus. They will also submit memorandum to Dhaka University vice-chancellor and IBA director in this connection.

They also threatened to go for a tough movement if their demands were not met soon.

The month-long online process of IBA admission starts today and will continue till November 4. The entry tests of IBA will be held on November 20.

The fresh decision of IBA admission coincided with that of the DU authorities that does not allow students to take the tests more than once.
