

LEAKING RESULTS Four DU staff suspended

DHAKA University authorities suspended four of its staff over allegations that they leaked the results of the university-affiliated private medical colleges to examinees before the official announcement of the results.

DU Proctor Prof M Amazad Ali confirmed the news to New Age Wednesday evening. The four staff members were suspended Tuesday

night and further action will be taken after investigation, he said.

The four staff members are exam control office security guard Abul Hossen, section officer Ranjan Chowdhury, staff Bidhan Chandra Roy and DU proctorial team member Shahadat Hossen.

They were arrested Tuesday night and later handed over to the Shabagh police station where a case was also filed, the DU proctor confirmed.
