

## DU suspends 3 students over molestation

UNIVERSITY of Dhaka on Thursday suspended three of its students, also activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League, the student wing of the ruling Awami League, over molesting a female student on early Wednesday.

The proctor of the university, M Amzad Ali, confirmed it to New Age on Thursday.

The suspended students are Ratul Hasan Naein of applied mathematics department, Amirul Islam of zoology and Nazmus Sakib of statistics department, respectively. All of them are first year students.

They all stay at Amar Ekushe Hall.

The students might be expelled after probing the magnitude of the crime they committed, the proctor added.

The DU authority also issued law-cause notices to the victim, a resident of Rokeya hall, and his boy friend, another DU student, asking what business they had at the Teachers Students Center premises so early in the morning, according to the proctor.

DU is likely to take actions against the female and her friend if they were found in breach of campus regulation, he added.

Earlier, police arrested these three BCL activists over molesting the student at the TSC premises around 1:30 am on Wednesday when she was accompanied by her friend.
