

## DU expels five students for Hizb ut-Tahrir links

THE Dhaka University authorities on Thursday expelled five students of business studies faculty for their alleged involvement with activities of the banned Islamic outfit Hizb ut-Tahrir.

They were Nure-Alam Md Sihab Uddin, MBA student of management and resident of Surya Sen Hall, Md Sayeedi Hasan Sajib, MBA student of management and resident of Bijoy Ekattar Hall, Tariqul Islam, MBA student of accounting and information system, Naqib Farhan, BBA student of AIS and Md Alamgir

Hossain, BBA student of AIS.

The university in a release said, 'Five students of Dhaka University were found distributing leaflets and CD of the banned group in different rooms of Business Studies Faculty which was detected in close circuit camera of the building. Such an incident by a student has put at risk safety of the DU and harmed its dignity which is violation of the discipline and laws of the university.'

For this reason, they have been expelled from the university temporarily according to section 5 (2) of pictorial rules, it added.
