

Former IU BCL activists continue demo demanding job

SOME former activists of Islamic University unit, of Bangladesh Chhatra League, ruling—Awami—League-backed student organisation, again locked the main entrance of the campus on Wednesday, demanding job at the university.

Witness said some former activists of BCL IU unit, including Taufiqur Rahman Hidar, Mizanur Rahman Titu, Ashikur Rahman Japan, Mohammad Ali Shimul, Arab Ali, Mahmud Hasan Lelin and Kasheni Mahmud, started their demonstration programme at about 8:00am and it continued till on 4:00pm.

The IU authorities said university vehicles from Kushtia and Jhenaidah could not enter the campus.

Academic and administrative activities of the university came to a halt and no class and examination was held in the last three days because of the demonstration programme, they added.

Ashikur Rahman Japan said they would continue their demonstration until the university authorities met their demand.
