

JCD president shown arrested in 6 arson cases

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) President Rajib Ahsan has been shown arrested in six arson cases, and remanded for eight days in four of the cases.

Hearing on a 20-day remand prayer was not held in two more cases as bail hearing of another accused in the cases was pending with a court.

Metropolitan Magistrate Shamsul Arefin allowed six days of remand for Rajib in three cases filed with Paltan and Motijheel police stations.

Metropolitan Magistrate Tarek Mainul Islam Bhuiyan granted police two more days to interrogate Rajib in another case filed over attack on Awami League lawmaker Chhabi Biswas on last December 24. On July 19, Rajib was held along with five others allegedly along with Yaba tablets in Patuakhali.
