

Primary, JSC results today

RESULTS of the primary and the ibtedayi completion examinations and Junior School Certificate and Junior Dakhil Certificate examinations will be published today.

Education minister Nurul Islam Nahid will formally announce the results of JSC and JDC exams at 1:30pm at a press conference in his secretariat office.

Primary and mass education minister Mostafizur Rahman will formally brief the media on the highlights of the primary and ibtedayi completion results at 12:30pm.

Prior to that, copies of the results will be handed over to prime minister Sheikh Hasina.

The examinees will be able to get their results at their respective schools. Besides, the results will also be made available on the websites of respective boards and directorate and through SMS.

The primary students will get results on the websites of Directorate of Primary Education: www.dpe.gov.bd and <http://dpe.teletalk.com.bd> while the JSC and JDC students can get their results on www.education-boardresults.gov.bd.

Around 32 lakh class V students took part in this year's primary education completion examinations and ibtedayi education completion examinations while more than 23 lakh class VIII students took part in the Junior School Certificate and Junior Dakhil Certificate exams.

This year's JSC and JDC exams were held on November 1 through 18 and primary examinations from November 22 to 30, respectively.
