

## BUET expels 3 students for 'indiscipline'

BANGLADESH University of Engineering and Technology authorities on Monday expelled one student for one term and two other students from their dormitory for their alleged indiscipline activities.

The BUET syndicate took the decision after an academic council meeting, said its vice-chancellor Khaleda Ekram.

Of the students, Riad was a third year student of Mechanical Engineering department while the names of two others were not confirmed immediately.

BUET students' welfare

centre director Delwar Hosain said they found several hundred visiting cards of Islami Shashontantra Chhatra Andolan, a student platform of religion based party Islami Andolan Bangladesh.

Earlier on the day, Bangladesh Chhatra League leaders and activists handed over ten students to the authorities for their suspicious activities.

The authorities interrogated them and took the decision.

BUET unit BCL general secretary Kanok told New Age that they caught these men at last night from Nazrul Islam dormitory with 'militant' books and compact discs.
