

# RU students protest at serving unhygienic food at hall

SEVERAL hundred students of the Syed Ameer Ali Hall at Rajshahi University on Friday protested against serving unhygienic foods in the dining hall allegedly due to indifference of the hall authorities.

The agitating students of the hall brought out a protest procession and laid siege the provost room protesting against serving of unhygienic foods.

The agitated students alleged that the hall authorities are serving low-quality food after taking enough money from the university authorities.

Abdur Rahman Ashik, one of the agitated students of the hall, said stale foods, dusts and insects are often found in the dining halls,

posing serious health risk.

Students fall sick after taking the foods, he continued.

Liton Hossain, another agitated students of the hall, said the quality of the food is so unhygienic that I feel sick when I take meal from the dining hall.

As a result, I have to cook in my room, he added.

However, the manager and the workers of the dining hall flew after hearing the students' movement.

Later, S M Mokhlesur Rahman, house tutor of the hall, assured the students that they would take proper steps soon after investigating into the matter.

Professor Mostafizur Rahman, provost of the hall, could not be reached for comments despite repeated attempts over mobile phone.
