

## SUST left, right teachers extend support to VC

LEFT, leaning pro-BNP, Jamaat and a faction of Awami League-backed teachers' forums of Shahjalal University of Science and Technology on Wednesday declared that they would extend all kinds of assistances to the vice-chancellor, Aminul Haque Bhuiyan.

They also urged the teachers, who have been on agitation for more than three

months demanding withdrawal of the vice-chancellor, to sit with the teachers' association for discussing their complaints.

They made the call during a rally held in front of the university registrar building.

They also requested the vice-chancellor to convene emergency meeting of the university administrative bodies including admission committee, academic coun-

cil, syndicate and selection board as soon as possible.

The AL-left leaning teachers' forum convener, Akhtarul Islam, pro-BNP and Jamaat teachers' forum convener Sajedul Karim, student affairs adviser Rashed Talukder, Professor Reja-E Karim Khandaker, Golam Ali Hayder and Sabina Islam and teachers' association president Kabir Hosain and syndicate member

SM Hasan Zakirul, among others, addressed the rally.

A section of pro-AL teachers started agitation on April 20 demanding withdrawal of the VC on allegations of irregularities, nepotism and misbehaviors with the teachers.

In the face of teachers' movement Aminul Haque was forced to go on two-month leave on April 23 citing personal ground.
