

## SUST teachers resume movement demanding VC's removal

TEACHERS of the Shahjalal University of Science and Technology resumed their movement on the campus on Thursday afternoon demanding immediate removal of the university vice-chancellor, Aminul Haque Bhuiyan, as he joined office after a two-month forced leave.

More than 50 teachers, under the banner of Muk-tijuddher Chetanay Udbud-dha Shikkhak Parishad, a fo-rum of the teachers inspired by the spirit of the liberation war, staged an hour-long sit-in in front of the Central Library Building to press home their demand.

At least 37 senior teach-ers also resigned from their administrative posts.

The forum acting con- vener, Nazia Chowdhury, while speaking at the rally, declared that they would ob-serve a sit-in in front of the Registrar Building on June 21 and would besiege the VC House on the campus on June 23 to press home the demand.

SUST syndicate mem- bers—Faruk Uddin, Moham- mad Yunus and Mustabur Rahman, among others, ad- dressed the rally.

SUST VC Aminul Haque was sent into a 2-month forced leave on April '23 in the face of the teachers' movement demanding his removal for his alleged in- volvement in corruption.

However, the VC denied the allegations against him.
