# Ministry stops teacher recruitment at non-govt edn institutes

NON-GOVERNMENT educational institutes should hold back from recruiting teachers until further instructions, read an education ministry circular on Wednesday.

The circular, signed by ministry additional secretary Chowdhury Mufad Ahmed, said the government had amended the Non-Government Teachers' Registration and Certification Authority Act 2005 by a Statutory Regulatory Or-

der on October 21, bringing some changes in the recruitment of teacher appointment to non-government educational institutes.

The changes include the creation of a Non-Government Teachers' Selection Commission that will appoint teachers to the non-government schools, colleges and madrassahs.

At present, the managing committee of non-government junior high schools, secondary schools, colleges, madrassahs, technical schools and vocational institutions

are the hiring authority.

The Wednesday's circular said the government will soon issue a circular detailing the change in recruitment process to non-government educational institutes. For the transitional period, the government to put on hold the appointment of teachers to non-government educational institutes, the circular said.

If any non government educational institutions appoint anyone after October 22 that will be deemed as unlawful.
