## JCD creating unrest in SM Hall

The activists of ruling BNP backed Jatiyatabdi Chhatra Dal (JCD) created turmoil at Salimullah Hall of Dhaka University to establish their supremacy on the general students.

The unruly JCD activists beat at least four general students during the last two weeks and had driven out some residents of the hall from their seats.

In a recent development of their muscle practice a group of JCD activists led by its Salimullah Hall unit President Linkon and General Secretary Shohag captured an allotted rooms of Khademul Islam Ridoy, General Secretary of Dhaka University Journalist Association (DUJA), and Emamul Haque Shamim, University Reporter of Daily Independent.

Sources said, now Linkon and Shohag are not students of Dhaka University and residing at the hall illegally.

The activists also threatened all journalists who are also residents of the hall to leave the hall or to face serious consequence.

The JCD activists, mainly arms cadre of its International Affair Secretary Sayid Ikbal Titu also physically harassed two journalists in presence of Salimullah Hall's provost and JCD DU Unit President and General Secretary on Friday night.

In the face of their continuous threat the DUJA on Friday withdrew all the working journalists from the hall.

The JCD in an emergency meeting on Saturday expelled six of its activists—Shagor, Sharif, Belal, Shamim, Babu and Sumon, from the organisation and suspended Zahirul Islam, Organising Secretary of the hall unit of JCD.

But the JCD served only a show cause notice against the Salimullah Hall unit JCD President Md. Mukit Linkon and General Secretary Monirul Islam Shohag for their involvement in journalists harassment incident.
