

Restore confidence in student politics Mannan tells JCD convention

LGRD Minister Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan yesterday called on the Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) leaders to restore the confidence of people in student politics.

"The people have no more confidence in student politics," said the minister while addressing the convention of JCD at the Teacher-Student Centre of Dhaka University.

The minister, who is also the secretary general of BNP, suggested that the convention should be held every year to bring new leadership in the committee.

"None should be allowed to hold the leadership permanently," he told the delegates representing all district units of JCD.

Mannan assured that the BNP high command would take initiative to implement the resolutions to be taken at the convention.

Mannan said a vested quarter is trying to tarnish the country's image abroad after the BNP-led four-party alliance came to power.

He criticised the Awami League for spreading false propaganda against the country.

Addressing the convention, Health and Family Welfare Minister Dr Khandakar Mosharraf Hossain stressed that the JCD should be strengthened to foil any conspiracy against the country.

State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Aamanullah Aman said Awami League will never return to power as it has destroyed the image of the country.
