Police entered the Central Library and Fine Arts Institute and charged baton on the students who were studying there at that time.

During the attack, Nazma Begum, Nazma Huq and Rafikunabi, teachers of Institute of Fine Arts were physically harassed by the police.

The sources said at about 1pm, some angry students beat up two assistant commissioners of police named Musfique and Moyeen with bamboo sticks in front of the Fine Arts Institute.

Sources at the DMCH said the post-accident clashes that continued till 4:30 PM left at least 60 people injured, including students, journalists and policemen. About 30 people received treatment at the hospital.

In the police attack, General Secretary of ruling BNP backed Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) Shaiful Islam Firoz, JCD leader Billal Hossain Tareq, Shamsuzoha Shumon were also injured.

Press photographers who were injured in the violence included Apu of Amar Desh, Shamim Noor of Jugantor, Raja of Bhorer Kago,

Abdur Rab, cameraman of Channel-1, Pintu, Cameraman of ATN Bangla, and Kajol Hajra and Rusel of Samakal and senior photographer Nabin.

Students said that, after the firefighters doused the fire, a traffic police sergeant on duty helped the partly burnt minibus to drive away.

The victim girl's body was sent to her resident at Panchagar amid huge protest. She will be buried there after Namj-e-Janaza. The classmates of Happy demanded to hold Namj-e-Janaza at the campus. But the university authorities sent the body of Happy to his village home fearing any untoward incidents.

However, six students' alliance led by BCL urged the university authorities to beg apology for the barbaric police attack on the students within 24 hours. Otherwise they will go for one point demand of resignation of VC and Proctor. They also staged demonstration on the campus today (Sunday) protesting the killing.

They also demanded punishment of the police officers who attacked on the teachers and students and bearing all expenses of the injured students.

Resident students of Rokeya Hall brought out a mourning procession on the campus on Saturday evening in the memory of Happy.

Students of Fine Arts Institute called a strike in the institute today (Sunday) protesting the police attack on the teachers and students.

All the examination of Psychology Department scheduled to be held on June 1 was suspended due to the killing of Happy.
