

BCL rival groups clash Central leader, 6 more injured on DU campus

A tense situation prevailing on Dhaka University campus following the series of clashes between two rival groups of Bangladesh Chhakra League (BCL) in the last couple of days.

A central BCL leader was beaten up on Sunday by a group of activists loyal to Hemayetuddin Khan Himu, General Secretary of DU unit of BCL on Sunday noon.

According to sources, the unruly BCL activists attacked a Joint Secretary level leader of BCL Central Committee in front of the Central Library at about 2.30 p.m. on Sunday. The identity of the leader could not be known.

The Sunday's attack came as a sequel to Saturday's attack on Himu group by another group led by Delwar Hossain, President of DU unit of BCL.

Meanwhile, Himu and Delwar groups logged into a chase and counter chase inside the Jagan-

nath Hall in the early hours on Sunday, leaving six more activists injured.

A series of clashes between two rival groups of BCL on DU campus on Saturday at least 10 leaders and activists including Hemayetuddin Himu were injured.

BCL sources said, Himu and his followers were seen assembling on campus since the very early morning though the central command of BCL post-poned all kinds of political activities of DU unit.

Meanwhile, a probe committee led by BCL President and General Secretary Liakot Sikder and Nazrul Islam Babu respectively started investigation into the incidents.

The probe body is likely to submit its report by May 19.
