Implementation of uni-track edn system postponed

The cabinet at its regular meeting on Monday approved a proposal for postponing the implementation of uni-track education system in class nine and ten till 2007, reports BSS.

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia presided over the meeting held at the Prime Minister's Office (PMO), an official handout said on Monday night.

The cabinet okayed a proposal

for amendment to some clauses of Bangladesh Telecommunications Act, 2001.

It also approved the draft of the Kabi Nazrul Islam University Law, 1995 with a view to expanding the scope for higher education and keeping alive the memories of the National Poet through establishing a university at Trishal in Mymensingh.

The meeting okayed the draft of

the Judiciary Administration Training Institute (Amendment) Act, 2005 with the aim of further amendment to the Judiciary Administration Training Institute Act, 1995, the handout said.

Cabinet members and concerned state ministers attended the meeting.
