

None of 409 schools pass SSC exams

All the examinees from ten institutions, including four from outside the capital, passed the SSC exam 2005 while none from as many as 409, reports UNB.

Holy Cross Girls School was shown on top of the list of top ten schools in terms of percentage of pass and appeared students.

The four schools listed from outside the city are Savar Cantonment Public School (91 students), Mirjapur Cadet College, Tangail (51), Bangladesh International School, Jeddah (50) and Cantonment Board High School, Tangail(43).

Cross School passed the SSC exam.

Rajuk Uttara Model School and College secured the second place on the list as its 196 students appeared and passed.

The other all-pass schools are Udayan Bidyalaya (138 students), Mohammedpur Preparatory & Girls High School (129), ST. Gregory's High School (110), Y W CA Girls High School (79).

The 409 institutions that have gone nil are mostly in rural areas where schools and madrasahs are reportedly set up and teachers recruited without proper planning.
