2nd senate session of KU held

KHULNA, Aug 15:—Second Senate session of Khulna University (KU) was held after 4 and a half years on August 9 at 11 am at the first academic building in the university.

The Vice-Chancellor Professor Dr. Md. Mahbubur Rahman presided over the session. The amendment budget of 2006-2007 and the budget for 2007-2008 fiscal was presented by the treasurer Sheikh Abdul Hasib.

The Vice-Chancellor said, Khulna University have to build a centre of excellence. Senate can play an important role regarding the conduct of the university, the VC added.

KU VC further said, Khulna University will show a new way to the nation and the country with the exercise of knowledge by its students.

It may be mentioned that there are 1364 teachers including 319 professors, 288 officials, 610 3rd class and 690 4th class staff in the University Organogram.

Treasurer Professor Sheikh Abdul Hasib said, Tk 15 crore and 40 lakh was approved by the University Grant Commission (UGC) among this amount Tk 60 lakh was obtained from the own sources income of the University.
