CU syndicate reviews probe report Justice Faizee's LLB certificate fake

CHITTAGONG, Mar 3: - The 439th syndicate of Chittagong University (CU) today nullified the certificate of Bachelor of Laws (LLB) what justice Faisal Mahmud Faizee had claimed to have conferred on him from the university.

The high court justice came at the center of controversy shortly after his joining as an additional justice of the high court on August 23, 2004. some newspapers in their scoops claimed that the certificate of the law graduation of the newly appointed justice was false.

The then authorities of Chittagong University formed a probe body and carried out investigation on the newspaper's claim. Unfortunately, the probe report was not



made public as the controversial justice had strong lobby in the ruling political camp and the university bigwigs.

Justice Faisal Mahmud Faizee

reportedly became a member of the bar council submitting the LLB certificate he claimed to have received from the university in 1989. He appeared the LLB examination from Chittagong Law College in 1988 and could not come out successful.

He subsequently worked as a lawyer at the high court for more than a decade and was chosen to be a justice during the BNP-Jamaaf regime.

The reporter, editor and publisher of the some newspapers who broke the news story on Faizee's false certificate were placed on trial at the high court and were convicted to jail. The convicted newsmen went to the Supreme Court seeking remedy against the high court verdict. The Supreme

Court took the case for review.

The CU syndicate that went into session this morning reviewed the detailed report of the probe body on Faizee's certificate and came to a consensus of nullifying the certificate calling it false.

Former Pro-Vice Chancellor of the CU Professor Mohammad Shamsuddin led the three-member probe committee.
