Call to save CU students from ICS activists

CHITTAGONG, July 18:-Resident students of Chittagong University (CU) urged the authorities concerned to save them from the clutch of Jamat-e-Islami backed Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS).

They said that the CU unit of ICS had been occupying the male dormitories like the previous governments and extorting a smart

amount of money from each of the resident student in the name of collecting 'Baitul Mal'.

"We're bound to give the money demanded by the ICS men mainly fearing humiliation and physical assault," resident students claimed.

Referring to the ban on political activities due to the country's ongoing state of emergency, the resident students also questioned that how the CU unit of the ICS had been operating at the dorms and on the campus?

They drew the attention of the caretaker government regarding the ICS operation and questioned grounds of sparing the anti-liberation forces from legal actions?

It is learnt that the CU unit of ICS had been accelerating their activities through organizing different programs at the seven male dorms regularly while other student bodies of the CU had been remaining themselves silent since the day of promulgation of country's state of emergence.

Russel Ahmed, a student of Shah Amanot Hall alleged that the resident students could not do anything freely at the dormitories due to the ICS cadres.

He urged the caretaker government's immediate intervention to the CU campus for saving the resident students from the clutch of ICS cadres and their cohorts.

Campus sources said that some of the CU top managements had been openly patronizing the ICS leaders and workers to open their activities on the campus.
