DU classes resume

Academic activities in the Dhaka University (DU) resumed on Saturday after three months of unscheduled closure.

Classes took place for three days only in the last 94 days beginning on October 20. No examinations were held during that period.

To mention, DU remained closed due to the indefinite student strike since Caretaker Government (CG) took over on October 28, 2006.

The university authority postponed all kinds of examinations for the fifth time till January 14 due to the political turmoil in the country.

The examinations postponed in last three months will begin from January 18. The fresh date of the examinations will be announced later.

However, the dates of the first year admission test were announced. According to new schedule the admission test of 'Ka' unit will be held on January 26, 'Kha' unit February 2, 'Gha' unit February 9 and the admission test of 'Ga' unit will be held on February 16.

According to sources, the resident students have started returning to their dormitories.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) is now back on the Dhaka University campus after five months. About hundred leaders and activists of BCL gathered at Modhu's canteen on Saturday morning. They also returned to their respective halls. Leaders of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) were present to the campus at that time.

Incident of chase and counter-chase took place between JCD and BCL activists. General students apprehended clash between the student organisations at Surya Sen Hall on Saturday.

However, a meeting of the university provost standing committee urged all the student organisations to ensure coexistence in dormitories.
