313 expelled in HSC exams 541,817 candidates appear in nine Edn Boards

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC), Alim and HSC in Business Management (BM) examinations began simultaneously across the country on Thursday, reports BSS.

A total of 5,41,817 candidates from 6,958 educational institutions are appearing in the examinations at 1,832 centres under nine education boards, marking

an increase of 23,154 examinees over the previous year.

Of the examinees, 4,40,248 are under seven Secondary and Higher Education Boards, 52,034 under the Madrasa Education Board and 49,535 under the Bangladesh Technical Board.

Education ministry sources said on the first day of the examinations, 313 students were expelled

across the country.

The board-wise expelled candidates: Dhaka Board-seven, Rajshahi Board-15, Comilla Board-six, Jessore Board-13, Chittagong Board-one, Barisal Board-nine, Sylhet Board-four, Madrasa Board-15 and Technical Board-243.

Quadri made a surprise visit to a number of examination centres in the capital city and talked with the examinees and the vigilance team members, said an official release of the education ministry.

The board-wise candidates are: Dhaka Board-129,179, Rajshahi Board-104,394, Comilla Board-46,573, Jessore Board-80,535, Chittagong Board-37,764, Barisal Board-24,599, Sylhet Board-17,204, Madrasa Board-52,034 and Technical Board-49,535.
