HSC, Alim, HSC (BM) exams begin today

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) and its equivalent examinations, including Alim and HSC (BM), under nine education boards will begin across the country today (Thursday), reports UNB.

Some 541,817 students, including 235,209 female, are going to appear for the exams this year under Dhaka, Rajshahi, Comilla, Jessore, Chittagong, Barisal, Sylhet, Madrasah and Technical education boards.

Of the total, 429,179 will appear under Dhaka Education Board, 104,394 under Rajshahi, 46,573 under Comilla, 80,535 under Jessore, 37,764 under Chittagong, 24,599 under Barisal and 17,204 under Sylhet education boards from a total of 1007 centres.

Some 52,034 students will appear in Alim exams under the Bangladesh Madrasah Education Board from 345 centres and 49,535 students will sit for HSC (BM) exams under the Bangladesh Technical Education Board from 480 centers.

Besides, some 166 candidates will sit for HSC exams in five centers abroad under the Dhaka Education Board. The centres are Jeddah, Riyadh, Tripoli, Doha and Abu Dhabi.

Meanwhile, Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) has slapped a ban on public entry into 200 yards of city centres during the examinations of HSC, Alim, Fazil and Kamil.

The ban will remain in force until the examinations are over, said a DMP Press release.
