## College teacher compelled to return govt money after 22 years

MAGURA, Nov 26:—Md. Hafizur Rahman, Assistant Professor of Economics Department of Magura Adarsha College continued his job in low institutions and drew the salary of govt. part from both the institutions.

It was known that he had drawn the salary of 34 months at the amount of about Tk. 50,000/- that came to light after 22 years. But he submitted the salary of two months at the amount of Tk. 1410/- to the treasury on 5<sup>th</sup> November.

Magura Adarsha College sources said, Md Hafizur Rahman joined the college on 30/09/1982. Before that he did his job as a teacher at Nakol Roy Charan High School under Sreepur upazila of the district.

He began to draw his salary

from the college as a full time lecturer from 1983. But at the same time he continued his job at the school and drew his salary from there as a full time teacher.

Later he drew the salary of 9 months at the amount of Tk. 6840/- from 01/06/1985 to 28/02/1986 after the college had been enlisted under MPO.

It was know from a letter sent by the acting headmaster of the school, Shafikul, Azam on 05/11/2007 that he received his salary from the school since May 1985. But it was known from a reliable source that he received his salary till July 1985 from the former school. The headmaster of the school admitted that Hafizur Rahman submitted Tk. 1410/- in favour of the Director General of the Secondary and Higher Secondary Adhidaptar at the Sreepur branch of Sonali Bank by Treasury Chalan No. 2 to 47-Education" sector. But there arose a question that why Hafizur submitted the salary of two months only.

Recently his birth date was sent 10<sup>th</sup> October, 1953 on the MPO sheet of the college but according to his SSC certificate it is 10<sup>th</sup> October 1951. Two years of his age has been reduced with some dishonest employees of the college. After being informed the Principal of the college and the Deputy Commissioner of the district and president of the college Governing Body sent a letter to the Director General of the Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Adhidaptar to amend the wrong.
