President opens countrywide text book distribution campaign

President and Chief Advisor Professor Dr Iajuddin Ahmed on Wednesday opened the countrywide textbook distribution campaign seeking cooperation of all in creating human resources by reaching benefits of education at every Doorstep, reports BSS.

"I urge all irrespective of party affiliations to extend their hands to create human resources and reach the benefits of education at every doorstep," he told the inauguration of textbooks for primary, secondary and Ittedayee levels at the international conference centre at the chief advisor's office.

The President expressed the hope that the private operators entrusted with the responsibility of distributing the textbooks to the schools and madrasas would reach the textbooks in time as per demand with their honesty, efficiency and commitment.

President Iajuddin delivered the textbooks to some students to mark the launching of the campaign of textbook distribution.

He thanked the education ministry and others concerned, including the Textbook Board officials, for their success for quick marketing of nearly 1.75 crore textbooks as they did over the past several years and asked the concerned officials to closely monitor the distribution campaign.
