CSP calls off strike on DU campus

Chhatra Sangram Parishad (CSP) led by BCL Sunday called off its indefinite strike on the Dhaka University campus.

The Parishad leaders announced the decision at a Press conference at the DUCSU Bhaban on Sunday noon.

Addressing a Press conference, BCL president Mahmudul Hasan Ripon said they have postponed the strike in the greater interest of the students of the country's premier institution.

However, he threatened to go on a tougher movement if their demand for peaceful coexistence in the DU dormitories and arrest of the armed cadres of JCD are not met soon.

"We have postponed the strike

for the sake of thousands of students. But our demands will have to be fulfilled, otherwise we will go on a tougher movement for the resignation of Vice-Chancellor, Proctor and Treasurer of the university," Ripon said.

Chhatra Sangram Parishad (CSP) also demanded cancellation of the 27th BCS examination alleging leakage of question papers.

Among others, BCL general secretary Mahfuzul Haider Chowdhury Rotan, JSD-backed Chhatra League president Shariful Kabir Swapan, BCL vice-president Aparna Paul and BCL central leaders Jasim Uddin Bhuiyan, Ashrafur Rahman and Ahsanullah Bashar were present at the Press conference.
