



Principal's office ransacked in Sirajganj

SIRAJGANJ, July 9.—Office of the Principal of Sirajganj Government College was ransacked by students of the college today (Tuesday).

Eye-witnesses said that at least 200 students of Sirajganj Government College brought out a procession in the campus and demanded to hold all examination in the college. They submitted a memorandum with the principal. Later some of the agitated students ransacked the office of the Principal and damaged some furniture. Police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control.

It may be mentioned here that the National University decided to hold all examinations in the college where the students did not become examinees.
