



BCL activists ransacked vehicles in Khulna

KHULNA, June 20: Activists of Bangladesh Chhaira League (BCL), student wing of main opposition party Awami League blocked city's Lower Jessore Road for three hours and ransacked few vehicles and restaurants at city's Khalishpur area this morning protesting the murder of BCL leader Masudur Rahaman Masud who succumbed to his injury on wednesday last, who was critically wounded by his rivals on Monday last.

Police said, BCL activists blocked Lower Jessore Road (Khalishpur Part) from 11 A.M to 2 P.M today disrupting vehicular traffic of this busy road protesting murder of BCL leader Masud. Road blockers ransacked glasses of few motor vehicles and furnitures of some roadside restaurants as those tried to defy BCL programme. But there was no report of arrest in this regard.

Meanwhile father of killed BCL leader Masud (25), Abdul Haque filed a case with Khalishpur thana accusing six persons of murdering his son yesterday night.

Masud was critically wounded on monday evening during a clash with his opponents in front of Khalishpur Port School. He was then admitted at Khulna Medical College Hospital but soon he was shifted to Dhaka Medical College hospital as his condition deteriorated where he succumbed to injury yesterday.

Masud was convenor of BCL Port School Unit under ward no.15 of Khulna city Corporation.
