



MBA course Admission seeker sues KU VC

KHULNA, May 27:—A female student aspiring admission in MBA course of Khulna University has filed a case with court accusing KU authority, including Vice Chancellor and Head of MBA Admission Committee of practicing irregularities while processing the admission.

The court receiving the complaint from Nazneen Nahar, daughter of SM Mokbul Hossain of city's Sher-e-Bangla Road, imposed an injunction on admission process today saying that no admission shall be made without taking Nazneen Nahar in MBA course of Khulna University as she properly qualified in the admission test.

Nazneen Nahar secured 29th place in admission test out of 30 reserved seats for MBA. But she was put in a waiting list violating the admission rules of KU Act. Bringing this charge she filed a case with the court of Assistant Judge, Batiaghata, Khulna on May 23 last. Eminent lawyer Advocate M. Enayet Ali prosecuted the case in favour of Nazneen.

When Nazneen contacted VC to know about this irregularity he expressed his ignorance about the decision of Admission Committee and took no step to rectify the fault, said father of the plaintiff.

Responding to the queries of journalists, Register of KU M. Amir Ali admitted that they has received injunction order and were considering about legal steps against the injunction.

Accused people are KU, VC M. Abdul Quadir Bhuiyan, ABM Rashiduzzaman, Syed Zabid Hossain, Nargis Akter and ASM Shahabuddin.
