



KU VC's house turned into club

KHULNA, May 17:—Khulna University authority has transformed the residence of Vice-Chancellor into Khulna University Club without any proper approval of higher authority.

VC's house which was built at a cost of Taka 70 lakh after approval of ECNEC (Executive Committee for National Economic Council) and KU syndicate is now the free amusement centre of teachers liked by VC Professor Abdul Quadir Bhuiyan.

The former VC now lives at a rented house at city's Nirala Residential area spending more than Taka 16 thousand each month with extra fuel cost for his transport — causing unnecessary pressure in KU.

As per demand of the students, teachers, and officials of KU ECNEC approved fund for a residence of VC inside the KU campus to help university activities go smoothly years before. With approval of KU Syndicate construction of the residence was completed early this year and the contractor handed over it to KU authority for use.

KU authority also bought furniture worth more than 5 lakh Taka for KU Club without any tender call.

When contacted concerned officers of KU refused to open mouth without permission of VC. VC was not found for comment when sought.
