Pink Panel demands reopening of DU Soon

Demanding immediate reopening of Dhaka University, teachers belonging to left-leaning Pink Panel on Saturday told acting Vice Chancellor Prof AFM Yusuf Haider that if the unwanted closure continues the campus situation would be deteriorated.

The teachers also urged the acting VC to be impartial in running the university. They asked him to ensure participation of all affiliations irrespective of political affiliation in combating any unwanted situation.

The left-leaning teachers called on Prof Haider at his office and gave him a statement depicting their stance on the campus situation. Prof Abu Zafar of Bangla Department led the delegation comprising Prof M Ashraf Ali, Prof Hashem Khan, Prof Fakrul Alam, Prof Kazi Nurul Islam, Prof M Imdadul Huq and Prof Nehal Karim.

They demanded of Acting VC to take necessary steps for withdrawing the cases filed against the teachers and students relating to the July 23 incidents and its backlash. They suggested the Prof Haider to create a neutral administrative structure to avoid any possible disaster like Shamsunnahar Hall tragedy.
