VC, DUTA express concern over campus situation

Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof. Elmajuddin Ahamed in a statement on Sunday expressed concern over the deteriorating law and order situation on the campus and sought cooperation of all quarters to maintain a congenial atmosphere in the university.

In the statement he said that a number of violent incidents including bomb blast, firing gunshots and arson took place at different points on the campus immediately after the formation of caretaker government on Saturday night panic had been

created among students, teachers and employees of Shahidullah Hall area following the exchange of gunshots on Saturday night, he said and added that the office room of Law Faculty Dean was set on fire and movement of armed youths on the campus had increased.

He called upon all quarters including political parties and student organisations to extend cooperation to university authorities in maintaining congenial atmosphere on the campus.

President of Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) Prof. A.T.M. Zahurul Haq and Dr A.A.M.S. Arefin Siddique expressed concern at the movement of armed youths on the campus and demanded immediate security measures for teachers and students.

DUTA leaders demanded of the caretaker government to take necessary step to recover illegal arms and arrest of terrorists from the university campus.
