

Alleged abduction

School teacher placed on 2-day police remand

School teacher Marzina Begum alias Hiramoni (40) was put on a two-day police remand on Sunday by the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (CMM) Court in the case of alleged kidnapping of four children from Motijheel area.

The allegations against the Marzina Begum is that she picked up two slum children Shoma (8) and Nasima (8) from Motijheel AGB colony market area on Wednesday and brought them to her residence at Shantinagar on Wednesday.

Later one of the victim Nasima got freed from the clutches of Marzina.

According to identification of Nasima, later the Motijheel Police recovered another three kidnapped children Soma (8), Bilkis alias Chhabi (8) and Mother Teresa (6) from Marzina's Shantinagar residence.

In this connection, one of the victim Soma's father Abdul Hai, filed a kidnapping case with Motijheel police station on Saturday. Motijheel police on Sunday produced the alleged child-trafficker Marzina before the court with a forwarding for granting a seven-day police custody.

After hearing Metropolitan Magistrate Khandaker Fatema Begum placed her on a two-day police remand.

On the otherhand, three children Soma, Chhabi and Nasima have been sent to their parents custody by the court.

Earlier, Metropolitan Magistrate Khandaker Fatema Begum recorded the statement of four children at her chamber.
